<p>Knowsley School Sports Partnership SLA. School to access local sports network which will provide entry to all KSSP competitions, subsidised access to high quality focused CPD for staff, provide curriculum support, schemes of learning and additional web based resources, provide leadership training for young people (eg. Playground leaders) and provide a PE and School Sport Health Check.</p>	£1250
<p><i>Intended Impact: The percentage of children who regularly access inter-school competition increases by 10% from previous academic year. Playground leaders are identified and complete appropriate training to support the development of playtime sports and games for children in KS1.</i></p>	
<p>Total Gymnastics Beth Tweddle’s School Gymnastics. Gymnastics in KS2 has been identified by the PE leader as an area for development through curriculum monitoring.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All KS2 children will access high quality gymnastic lessons that develop a wide spectrum of skills. Challenge and support is provided to all ability levels All KS2 staff will receive continuous CPD for 12 weeks working alongside a qualified coach. Planning/in depth lesson plans are provided to support delivering future sessions KS1 pupils have an opportunity to participate in an after school gym club. 	£3240
<p><i>Intended Impact: All children have access to high quality sustainable gymnastic lessons that meets the needs and skill levels of all pupils across KS2. Talented gymnasts are identified and able to access inter-school competition. Early gymnastic skills are developed in Y2 through access to after school provision in a club that may not normally be accessible.</i></p>	
<p>Judo Education All children in Y2, Y3 and Y4 will complete a 5 week course in Judo that introduces them to a new Olympic sport and actively encourages them to become engaged with sport. Lunchtime clubs to be run that will be partially subsidised</p>	£1375

ENRICH sports coaching- 10 hours sports coaching delivered as part of SLA to be used to introduce children to a new activity tri-golf. All children in Y3 and Y4 will have access to these sessions.	£300
<i>Intended Impact: A new sport is delivered in school that children actively engages the children to become engaged in sport.</i>	
ENRICH OAA Learning Package School will be provided with a bespoke orienteering course, map and markers, associated resource pack and staff CPD will be completed. This will result in all children will be able to complete school based orienteering	£800
<i>Intended Impact: The extensive school grounds are utilised well to engage the children in physical OAA activity through the provision of an outdoor orienteering course. Staff training completed will ensure full levels of support and challenge can be given to all pupils of various ability levels.</i>	
Athletics developments Children in Y5 and Y6 participate in ESAA Award Scheme and develop their athletic skills through directed training and competitive targets resulting in the awarding of badges.	£1000
<i>Intended Impact: All children in Y5 and Y6 are involved in the ESAA Award scheme and are able to achieve success in athletics. Intra school competition is developed in athletics to motivate and engage pupils and identify talented athletes to take part in inter-school competition.</i>	
PE Equipment Update PE equipment to ensure resources are available to provide high quality PE and sport opportunities both within and outside of curriculum time.	£1000
