Curriculum

<u>Maths</u> – We have had a busy couple of weeks since I last issued a newsletter. We have completed a unit of work on measurement, ensuring children know to convert metric units. For example, converting kilograms to grams and the inverse. We then moved on to negative numbers. We have been analysing our number system and completing calculations that bridge over 0.

<u>English</u> – Our newest text, The Templeton Twins has been one of absolute joy. It is written from the viewpoint of a narrator who is extremely sarcastic and whitty. The children have loved 'responding' to his questions and challenging his thoughts. We have reached the ending of this book and are now designing our own latest inventions and creating stories based on these.
