Curriculum

<u>Maths</u> – We are now coming to the end of our Algebra unit. The child have been phenomenal! They are now completing more difficult algebraic equations, including finding the inverse of operations to solve missing number problems. Can you solve: What is the value of c, when n = 8. C = 4(n+8) - 7

<u>English</u> – The children have been reading Lost Happy Endings, written by Carol Ann Duffy. They are not writing their own prequel to the story, imagining how the children may have lived before she turned 'evil' in the story. Some of the ideas that the children have come up with today in their planning are AMAZING and I am excited to read their stories.

<u>Reading</u> – We are almost at the end of our novel, Cogheart. This week children have been using a range of skills: summarising, sequencing and inferring. They are excited to find out what happens next and if Lily ever finds her missing father.
