## <u>English</u>

We have now completed our Golidlocks and the Three Bears stories and I am so proud of the writing that the children have produced at such an early stage of the year. Well done! Our next unit of English is based on the text The Dragon Machine by Helen Ward. During the next few weeks, the children will learn how to use prepositional language to describe settings and how to use conjunctions to extend their sentences.

## <u>Maths</u>

We have now started our next chapter of learning in maths which is focussed on addition and sub traction. In this unit, the children will learn simple adding and subtracting as well as how to use written methods to add and subtract with renaming.

## **Phonics**

The children are now very settled into their new phonics groups and are working super hard to develop their reading skills. Reading is one of the most important and integral skills for our children at Whiston Willis and we continue to encourage all parents to read with their children for at least 10 minutes per evening. All children have now been provided with new Reading Records and books to taken home. Please record any home reading in their record books after each reading session. Thank you.

## <u>PE</u>

Our PE days for this half term are Tuesdays and Thursdays whereby the children will be completing both a fitness and a skills unit of work. Please can you ensure that your child is provided with the correct Whiston Willis School PE kit (full details can be found on our website) and also a water bottle.
