CURRICULUM

Guided Reading

Koala Class are currently reading **Real-Life Mysteries: Can You Explain the Unexplained?** by Susan Martineau and Vicky Barker. This week, children have: predicted what might happen from details stated and implied; explained how information is related to meaning; retrieved and recorded key information from non-fiction; summarised the main ideas from multiple paragraphs; and, made inferences and justified using evidence.

English

Alongside our Guided Reading text, in English we are also reading **Templeton Twins Have an Idea** by Ellis Weiner and Jeremy Holmes. This week, children have: asked questions to make predictions; made inferences about a character; and, written a diary entry.

Maths

Children are currently using their knowledge and understanding of fractions to complete our topic on **Decimals** where they are: reading and writing decimals; comparing decimals; writing fraction and decimal equivalents; adding and subtracting decimals; and, rounding decimals.

Science/ Computing/ Geography

Our current Year 5 topics are Electrical Circuits (new); Game Creator (continued) and USA (continued).
