CURRICULUM

Guided Reading

We continue to read the book **The Story of Titanic for Children**. This week, children have: summarised key information from the text; explored the meaning and effect of word choices within sentences; and, identified and distinguished between retrieval and inference questions.

English

Koalas have completed their topic based on the book **Anne Frank** by Josephine Poole and Angela Barrett. This week, in addition to other writing, children have written a newspaper article and written an opinion piece.

Maths

In our new topic on **Graphs**, children will (or already have), read tables and read line graphs. Our next topic after this is **Fractions**.

Science

Our lesson questions within our topic on **Physical and Chemical Changes** are: What happens during a state change?; What is a physical change and how can we identify them? What is a chemical change and how can we identify them? How do physical and chemical changes compare? What can we do to investigate chemical changes? What happens when we place metals in acid?
