English

We have almost completed our English text- The Water Protectors and the children have really enjoyed learning about the Sioux tribe as well as researching lots of facts related to water pollution. Our next unit of work is based on the text The Bear and the Piano by David Litchfield. The story follows a young bear who stumbles upon something he has never seen before. As time passes, he teaches himself how to play the strange instrument - and, eventually, the beautiful sounds are heard by a father and son who are picnicking in the woods. The bear's piano playing makes him a huge star, but he misses the friends and family he has left behind. In this unit, the children will learn how to use noun phrases to describe character's and setting before writing our own narratives.

Maths

Our current chapter of maths is Money. We will be reviewing concepts on writing and counting money in addition to extending our knowledge of how to represent money using £ and p. We will be reinforcing previous counting methods using fives and tens to count quickly and efficiently. By the end of the unit, we will be using bar modelling to calculate the total amount of money spent and then working out how much change is required from amounts below £100.
