PSHE

Celebrating Difference – children will explore cultural differences and how they can cause conflict. They will explore racism and different types of bullying as well as name-calling and the impact this can have on others.

Music

Livin' on a Prayer – children will study this rock song. They will listen and appraise and sing the song and then perform.

Gym Sequences – children will learn to identify and practise body shapes and balances

Step to the Beat – children will understand the importance of a warm-up, and develop co-ordination and balance.

Computing

Spreadsheets – children will use formulae within a spreadsheet to convert measurements of length and distance and use the count tool to answer hypotheses about common letters in use.

Maths

Children will learn to read and write decimals to thousandths and to divide whole numbers by larger whole numbers. They will learn to divide whole numbers by larger whole numbers. Children will then convert common measurements into metres, centimetres and millimetres using knowledge of decimals and fractions to help convert units.

Geography

The Polar Regions – children will learn all about The Polar Regions located in the Arctic and Antarctic. They will learn about the countries which inhabitant the Polar Regions and the physical features. They will also learn about Global Warming and the affect that this is having on our planet
