Guided Reading

- ❖ We finished the Firework Maker's Daughter last week – which we loved- and we have started our new non-fiction book, Viking Voyagers. We are absolutely loving this book and have learned so much already!

English

- ❖ We started our new book in English called Cinnamon by Neil Gaiman! We really love this author and so far we have written letters in role as the characters and a diary entry. Ask your child what is special about Cinnamon and how her mother and father are feeling about this?

Maths

- ❖ Children have moved onto addition and subtraction and we have learned a range of methods to help us to find the total. We then moved on to mental strategies and word problems. We are trying so hard in maths and being reflective learners!

Science

- ❖ In our work around Practical Skills we have thinking about why a method is important and how we use data in an investigation. Ask your child what is important to include in a method?

Geography/ Design Technology

- ❖ In Geography, we have learned the regions of England and the counties of the North West. We have also explored the use of the 8 compass points for directional accuracy. Ask your child what region they live? Can they remember what county they live in?
