### Messages

### Guided Reading

- ❖ We are currently reading the book 'Annie Lumsden, The Girl from the Sea' by Beatrice Alemagna in Guided Reading, where children have: made predictions based on the title, front cover and the blurb; explained how meaning is enhanced through word choice; made inferences supported with evidence; made comparisons within the text; and, explained the meaning of words in context.

### English

- ❖ Our next book in English is named 'Winter's Child' by Angela McAllister. Using this text, children will: make predictions and inferences; place possessive apostrophes accurately within words; use prepositional phrases to write a recount; use the conventions of speech to show a character's feelings; identify and use a range of different types of noun phrase; and, use noun phrases within a letter.

### Maths

- ❖ Children have moved onto 'Chapter 6 – Fractions' where they are: counting in hundredths; writing mixed numbers; showing mixed numbers on a number line; finding equivalent fractions; simplifying mixed numbers; simplifying improper fractions; adding fractions; subtracting fractions; and, solving word problems.
