Activities : Phonics, Literacy, maths, Music		
English	<p>Children please look at the phonic worksheet and time table for the corresponding sounds , “p”, “or” shut the door, “are” care and share.</p> <p>Literacy- Can you complete the pirate ship 2do on purple mash? Decorate your pirate ship as if you were a real pirate.</p>  <p>Pirate Ship</p> <p>Star Challenge- Can you write a sentence about where you would sail to if you were a pirate?</p>	
Maths	<p>Number of the week 13</p> <p>Pirate Snacks -Have 2 plates in front of you with 13 objects to represent pirate cookies. (These could be lego, small circles, counters, beads whatever you can find) Give your child a plate and you have the other. Firstly put 5 of your things on your child’s plate and the remaining 8 on your plate. Ask questions such as ‘Who has more? Who has less? How do you know? Are they the same? Why not? Repeat with other amounts e.g. 6 on your plate and 7 on the other. Ask the same questions to your child.</p> <p>Star Challenge - Can you write some of the number sentences e.g. $10 + 3 = 13$, $9 + 4 = 13$.</p>
