Activities : Phonics, Literacy, maths, Science			
English	<p>Children please look at the phonic worksheet and time table for the corresponding sounds , “g”, “air” that’s not fair, “ur” nurse with a purse.</p> <p>Literacy- Click on the link and watch the story ‘Pete the cat and the treasure map.’ Then can you complete the make your own treasure map 2do on purple mash.</p>  <p>Treasure Map</p> <p>Star Challenge - Can you make your own treasure map on paper and write labels e.g. the sea, the sand, x marks the spot etc.</p>		
Maths	<p>Number of the week 13</p> <p>Number Hunt</p> <p>Hide some numbers (10, 11, 12 and our number of the week 13) outside or inside. Tell your child that you are going to go on a pirate number hunt. You could even dress up as a pirate to make it more fun! Once your child has found the number they then have to count that amount of e.g. pasta. This is reinforcing our number recognition and counting skills.</p> <p>Star Challenge - Can you tell your grown up which number is one more or less than 10, 11, 12 and 13? You could use a number line to help you.</p>
