Lesson 13	<p><u>LO: I can use a range of modal verbs to explore possibilities.</u></p> <p>This suitcase has arrived in our virtual classroom.</p> <p>Recap: modal verbs are verbs that indicate likelihood, ability, permission or obligation.</p> <p><u>Words like:</u> can/could, may/might, will/would, shall/should, must</p> <p>Pose questions about the suitcase using modal verbs.</p> <p><u>Activity:</u> (Go to Purple Mash 2Do - English lesson 13) Ask questions about the suitcase and the image using modal verbs and talk to the hand sheet.</p> <p>Save your work and hand it in to your teacher.</p>	
Lesson 14	<p><u>LO: I can identify verbs for different thoughts and feelings from a short film.</u></p> <p>Explore the following words: refugee, asylum seeker, traveller, immigrant, illegal immigrant, alien</p> <p>Do you know what these words mean? What does the word 'home' mean to you?</p> <p>Look up the meaning of the words. These are contentious words and their meanings are often confused.</p>
