Rules

Lesson 10

- Inverted commas go around the parts of the sentence that are being spoken
- Comma to separate what is being said
- Punctuation sits inside the closing inverted commas
- When two people are having a conversation; new line, new speaker
- Spoken sentences must start with a capital letter

Imagine you are looking at an image, like the one from the opening of the story, of you taken in school by a new child. Think about the new child and the day they arrived at your school.

Read the modelled write on Purple Mash, using speech to build up tension and atmosphere.

Activity:

(Go to Purple Mash 2Do - English lesson 10) Children to write their own story opening using their story plans from last week. Encourage them to use the rules of speech to create an imagined scene in the classroom, using a mixture of questions, commands, statements and exclamations.

Save your work in your online tray in English as lesson 10.

LO: I understand the rules for beginning new paragraphs

Recap the reasons for starting a new paragraph:

Lesson II	- Time - Person speaking - Topic - Place Think about the moment Chingis asked Julie to be his 'good guide'. You will now write the next section of the story where your 'good giode' is chosen. Activity: (Go to Purple Mash 2Do - English lesson II) Write the 'middle section' of the story, focusing on the rules for paragraphs. Read modelled example. Save your work in your online tray in English as lesson II.
Lesson 12	LO: I can use emotive language. Think about how the characters felt when Julie visited Chingis' home. Children will now write the next part of their stories where they visit the home of the new arrival. Refer back to the rules for paragraphing. Activity: (Go to Purple Mash 2Do - English lesson 12) Write the next part of the story where you visit their house. Save your work in your online tray in English as lesson 12.
