Key Facts:

- There are 4 cardinal points e.g. north, east, south and west.
- These are used for directions.
- North never changes.

Cardinal Directions are the four points on a compass E.g. North, South, East and West.

Activity

For this activity, you can go for a walk around your neighbourhood. This activity will work best if you are with an adult and have a compass. An adult usually should have a compass on their phone.

Step 1. Get a piece of paper and draw a picture of your house in the middle of it.

Step 2. When you step out your house, what way are you facing? Label this on your piece of paper/ map. Draw a picture or take a photo of what you see in front of you.

Step 3. If you walk east of your house, what can you see?

Step 4. If you walk west of your house, what can you see?

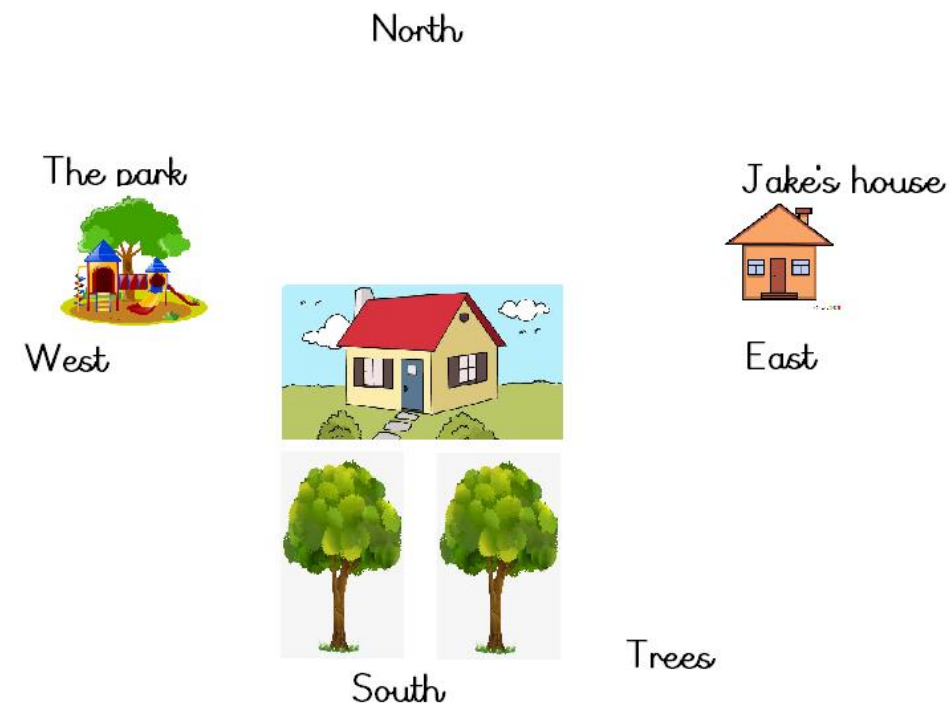


Step 5. What is south of your house?
