### Key Facts:

- The world is made up of 7 continents; North America, South America, Africa, Europe, Asia, Antarctica and Australasia.
- Antarctica is the coldest continent in the world and the hottest continent in the world is Africa.
- The earth is usually warmest nearest to the equator - this is why Africa is the hottest continent.

### Vocabulary:

- **Weather** - the day to day changes that we see happen. So, it can be sunny one day and rainy the next.
- **Climate** - the average weather usually taken over 30 years for a particular place.
