All children in Reception are settling into routines well and establishing good relationships with peers and staff. The children are really enjoying out outdoor provision and are becoming more independent every day! Phonics

Our phonic sessions are all following the Read, Write, Inc scheme. The taught sounds so far are 'm, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f'

Can your child remember the sounds? Can they identify objects that begin with that sound? You could practise writing these sounds at home!

Can you also practise writing your **name** at home?

Literacy

In Reception, the children have been naming characters from our Literacy text – Where The Wild Things Are and sequencing the story. In provision, children have had the opportunity to role-play using character masks. Please remember to look at our Twitter feed to see the wonderful work that is happening.

Maths

Within maths, children are working with numbers within 5. This week, we have focussed on number composition. Children enjoy investigating part-whole relations, e.g. seeing that 3 can be composed of 1 and 2. Children enjoy representing their work using objects in the environment investigate part-whole relations.

General

This half term in PE the children are developing the fundamental skills of balance, agility and coordination. Each lesson will be developing these key skills to support children physically. PE kits to be worn on a **Monday** please. Children have opportunities to write their name every day but can this be practised at home please.
