Literacy

We have been reading The Magic Paintbrush in Literacy. Children have enjoyed painting their own items for the poor and have been sorting useful and non-useful items. Children have written in role as Shen and also labelled the beast who helps free her. They have been exploring who the characters are, where the story is set and what happens in the beginning middle and end.

Maths

This week in maths children have been enhancing their counting skills. Children have been able to organise Numberblocks and match the correct numeral. They have had the opportunity to create their own Numberblocks using loose parts, interlocking cubes and squares of card.
