## Dear Parents/Carers,

Our World Book Day activities proved popular with our children again this year and they enjoyed the opportunity to engage in reading activities, have hot chocolate and biscuits as they read and receive a World Book Day book. A big thank you to all the staff who helped to arrange the day, order and collect our books and plan the activities that were completed. Also, thanks again to the PTA who paid for the hot chocolate and biscuits for the children to enjoy.

Also this week, we have had a Peer Review of our work in maths undertaken by three other headteachers from across Wade Deacon Trust and Warrington Primary Multi Academy Trust. All three were impressed by the quality of work being completed by children from nursery to Y6 and the progress the children have made in maths since September. As always, the behaviour of the children and their attitudes to learning was seen as being excellent which is always great to be acknowledged.

I have had the opportunity in recent weeks to visit many classrooms and speak to children about their learning as part of our regular monitoring and evaluation of the work we complete in order to improve. I have seen some exceptional learning and pupil outcomes across the school that highlights the quality of teaching and learning. The examples of pupil outcomes that I have seen clearly show the progress pupils have made in their calculations, handwriting and writing in maths and English but also I have seen excellent quality outcomes in art and geography. When the children are the best versions of themselves regularly, they do so well, when they are less consistent in their effort they do make less progress. Please do work with us to ensure your children come to school with a positive mindset having had plenty of sleep!

We have had children represent the school this week in football competitions and they have been excellent role models and representatives of our school. Well done to the Girls Football Team who have reached a finals day.


