# **Wolf Class Newsletter**

#### Update

What a fantastic couple of weeks we have had in Wolf Class! Children enjoyed celebrating World Book Day in comfort, by wearing their nightwear and sharing their favourite books. Some children from Years 4 and 5 were fortunate enough to be selected to attend a reading focussed workshop at Anfield. #### **English**

Alongside our Guided Reading text, in English we are also reading Templeton Twins by Ellis Weiner and Jeremy Holmes. Over the
past two weeks, children have written diary entries and letters in role of characters ensuring they are using emotions. Next week
children will begin to apply their learning by planning and writing their own narratives.

#### **Maths**

• Year 6 have been making connections between area and volume before starting their unit of work on 'Geometry' focussing on finding angles using the information provided. Next, they will begin to measure angles using protractors. Year 5 have been introduced to percentages and have made connections with fractions and decimals- they understand that fractions a out of 100. Next they will also begin to expand their knowledge of angles and begin to use protractors to measure angles.

### Reading

Wolf Class are currently reading Real-Life Mysteries: Can You Explain the Unexplained? by Susan Martineau and Vicky Barker. This
week, children have: predicted what might happen from details stated and implied; explained how information is related to
meaning; retrieved and recorded key information from non-fiction; summarised the main ideas from multiple paragraphs; and,
made inferences and justified using evidence. Children have loved learning about UFO's, Sea Creatures and Crop Circles. Based on
the evidence, what do they believe?

### Geography

As our unit of learning on the USA comes to an end, children have demonstrated their learning by planning their end of unit essay.
 It is fantastic to listen to the facts and information learnt by all children and I look forward to the children writing their essays over the coming weeks.

#### <u>Art</u>

Wolf class have spent the past few weeks being architects. They have used the work of Zaha Hadid to inspire them to create their
own building designs that are futuristic and unique. Although some children may have struggled, it is fantastic to see them reflect
and evaluate their work effectively. Children have begged to produce new designs as they are keen to show their evaluation.
